#### **Diversity**

India is a country of much diversity. We speak different languages, have various types of food, celebrate different festivals, and practise different religions. We do many things that are similar but we do them in different ways.

Let us do the following activities on diversity and record them on coloured A4 sheets.

#### **English**

Q1. During your summer holidays, visit the home of a friend or neighbour from another state. Find out the following:

*(Yellow colour A4 size sheets)*

- i. The festivals the family celebrates.
- ii. Their traditional clothes.
- iii. The language they speak.
- iv. Some tourist spots, places of interest in their home state.

While doing the above, try approaching a person/family whose state is quite far away from yours. For e.g., if you are from North India, choose a family from South India. If you are from Gujarat or Rajasthan, you could approach a friend from the Northeast. The idea is to learn from cultures that are different from our own.

You could even approach people who live in rural areas for a more enriching experience.

#### **Social Studies**

*(Green colour A4 size sheets)*

Describe the physical features of any two of the following states in your own words. (with pictures).

- a. Meghalaya
- b. Rajasthan
- c. Punjab
- d. Uttarakhand

Write the temperature and rainfall of the two states in January, June and September.

Make a list of foods that are cooked here, crops that are grown here and traditional clothes that people wear.

See how climate affects food, clothes and grains in these places.

- c. Fold it further into half to get an angle of  $45^\circ$ .
- d. Keep on repeating the above to get angles of  $15^\circ$ ,  $30^\circ$ , and so on.
- e. Open all the folds and mark the angles.

3. Take a leaf. Place it on a graph paper. Draw its outline. Calculate the area enclosed by taking the area of each square as  $1\text{cm}^2$ . Working to be done on a separate sheet of paper.

## **Science**

1. Find out the area of an irregular object by using a string/thread and a graph paper /square note book sheet.
2. Find out the area of your own study table/any other table in your house.
3. Take a few liquids (like water+oil, vinegar+water, dettol+water, milk+water etc.).Find out whether they mix completely or not. Note down all your observations and prepare a list of Immiscible and miscible liquids out of these.
